Video Book review contest 2020/2021

To celebrate Book Day on April 23rd, The Bilingual section is holding a reading contest in which you have to record yourself reviewing a book you've read in English.

There will be 6 categories, one per level.

Requirements

The basic idea is to share your opinion on the book to convince other students to read it or to avoid it, so record a <u>4-5 minute video</u> analyzing the following elements of the book:

- Personal introduction
- Title of the book and why you chose it.
- Plot summary (less than a minute)
- Are there any relevant characters? If not, why not?
- Personal opinion.
- What you have learnt: cultural aspects, values...
- Choose three words or expressions and say why they are relevant for you.
- Why do you recommend it?

Evaluation criteria

Your English skills: pronunciation (language), content (complete task). Audio/Video and creativity quality will be considered too!

Prizes*

The winner of each level will win a **30-euro voucher** to buy locally. Your review will benefit your English mark depending on its quality.

Once you have your final version of the video, upload it to your @educacion.navarra.es Drive and share it with inglescorella@gmail.com before 21st March.
